



TRIP TO THENFORD ARBORETUM, SATURDAY 10TH JUNE

The details of our trip to Thenford Arboretum on Saturday 10th June have now been finalised. The coach will be leaving from Tadworth Street, Tadworth, near the railway bridge and traffic lights, at 09.15, from Walton, by the chemist's, at 09.20 and from St. Andrew's Church, Kingswood at 09.30. Thenford Arboretum is situated near Banbury and is the 70-acre estate belonging to Lord (Michael) and Lady Heseltine. They have spent the last 40 years transforming and expanding a wild, overgrown, woodland into the stunning park and gardens we can see today. Thenford is open only four times a year to the general public and our visit promises to be a very special occasion.
